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			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ELA: Story writing, research (Alberta Provincial Park, got feedback and then applied that feedback to another topic), Words Their Way (spelling, patterns in spelling to improve their spelling) and grammar, Writing (informative texts, fiction and poetry), novel study • Math: patterns and number patterns, numbers sense (up to 10, 000), statistics and probability (graph building and interpretation), measurement (time, length, area), addition & subtraction, multiplication and division, long division and long multiplication, fractions & decimals, shapes and forms, 2D shapes and 3D objects – big focus on different strategies/approaches to problems, work with different surfaces – main focus is through problem solving (reading in french, try to understand what is important, what is being asked, and then figure out how to solve it) • Social Studies: Exploring and representing the history and characteristics of the land (why does alberta have its topography, climate, vegetation, animals, lakes/rivers), understanding the ways of life of First Nations populations in Alberta prior to colonization, Applying historical thinking to understand changes in Alberta over the past 250 years, examining different populations that make up the fabric of Alberta's population, la francophonie in Alberta • Science: Waste and our World, Light and Shadow, Wheels and Levers, Building Devices and Vehicles, Plants – curriculum emphasizes teamwork, cooperation, encourages students to ask good questions and work together in curiosity
